## **Human Subjects Narrative**

For the human subjects narrative, detail the following:

- **State the purpose of the study**. Share the objectives of the research and any hypothesis you have developed and will explore.
- Explain the rationale/need for your approach to addressing the problem. Describe why your approach is appropriate and why there will be minimal risk to participants. Add information on the data the project is expected to generate, such gained through use of videos, and how you will avoid risk in working with these data.
- **Describe the methods and procedures**. Tell us what subjects you will be working with, their potential vulnerabilities, and steps you will take to ensure minimal risk to participants. Describe the data to be collected and how these will be de-identified, stored and analyzed. Add any further information on how you will avoid risk in working with these data.
- Note the appropriate training by your research team. Note that all personnel in your project who conduct research involving human subjects have completed human subjects protections training, and that this training is up to date.
